Biographical Information

Rev. Arthur Morgan Lindsay (Art) and Ann MacInnes Lindsay were married 60 years and were appointed to Brazil as Presbyterian Missionaries in 1954, and for 25 years served on the mission field where Anne taught middle and high school English at the Colégio XV de Novembro and Bible at the Instituto Bíblico do Norte in Brazil. In 1979 Anne and Art went to York County, SC, where Anne worked as Interim Director of Christian Education at York Presbyterian Church. They later moved to Hampton SC.
